

### WHAT IS THE GATES MILLENNIUM SCHOLARS PROGRAM?

The **Gates Millennium Scholars (GMS) Program**, was established in 1999 by a \$1.6 billion grant from the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation to UNCF—the United Negro College Fund—the nation's largest and most effective minority education organization. The goal of GMS is to educate “**Leaders for America's Future**”™ by providing eligible students with the opportunity to complete an undergraduate college education in the discipline of their choice and continue through to a doctoral degree in seven GMS funded fields.

### WHO SHOULD ATTEND? STUDENTS WHO ARE...

- ❑ African American, American Indian/Alaska Native, Asian Pacific Islander American or Hispanic American; and
- ❑ 10th graders who have attained a cumulative GPA of 2.8 or above, 11th graders who have attained a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above, 12th graders who have attained a cumulative GPA of 3.3 or above, all on a 4.0 unweighted scale, and those who have earned a GED. (9th graders and GED recipients have no GPA requirement to attend.)
